This procedure is generally applied to swimming pool walls but can be used for any ceramic tile wall.

BEFORE

- 1. ASSEMBLE CLEANING SUPPLIES AND TOOLS. Supplies necessary for the job include:
 - Tile-Klenz for cleaning ceramic tile
 - MSDS for cleaning chemical
 - Doodle bug with brown-n-scrub pad on extension pole
 - Bucket
 - Required PPE
- 2. PLACE CAUTION SIGNS. Place "Caution" signs at access points to the area to be cleaned.
- PUT ON PPE. Tile-Klenz is corrosive and can burn the skin and eyes on contact.

DURING

- 1. WASH WALLS FROM THE BOTTOM UP.
- 2. ERGONOMIC TIPS.
 - Try to keep your back, wrists, arms, and shoulders in as neutral a posture as possible such that you are not over-reaching or straining. Let the extension do the work.
 - Switch hands periodically to avoid fatigue.
