This procedure is generally applied to swimming pool walls but can be used for any ceramic tile wall.

## **BEFORE**

1. **ASSEMBLE CLEANING SUPPLIES AND TOOLS.** Supplies necessary for the job include:
  - Tile-Klenz for cleaning ceramic tile
  - MSDS for cleaning chemical
  - Doodle bug with brown-n-scrub pad on extension pole
  - Bucket
  - Required PPE
2. **PLACE CAUTION SIGNS.** Place “Caution” signs at access points to the area to be cleaned.
3. **PUT ON PPE.** Tile-Klenz is corrosive and can burn the skin and eyes on contact.

## **DURING**

1. **WASH WALLS FROM THE BOTTOM UP.**
2. **ERGONOMIC TIPS.**
  - Try to keep your back, wrists, arms, and shoulders in as neutral a posture as possible such that you are not over-reaching or straining. Let the extension do the work.
  - Switch hands periodically to avoid fatigue.
