TRANSPORTATION REGULATORY EXEMPTION APPLICATION/VARIANCE

The California Code of Regulations (Cal. Code Regs.), title 22, division 4.5, chapter 13, article 4 (article 4) establishes four categories of transportation variances. Each variance category corresponds to a specific type of hazardous waste transportation operation, which, if conducted in accordance with the provisions of article 4, poses an insignificant risk to human health or to the environment. When signed in Part E by an authorized representative of the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) this document becomes the issued variance as applied for. Prior to operating pursuant to this variance, a transporter shall send a copy of this variance to each hazardous waste generator serviced under its provisions. Emergency Response Incident Operations, Cal. Code Regs., title 22, section 66263.43.

Allows a State, local or county governmental emergency response incident unit to transport up to five 85-gallon drums of hazardous waste from an incident site to a central collection facility using a shipping paper instead of a hazardous waste manifest. The waste may be accumulated for up to 90 days, and must then be manifested to an authorized facility.



Polychlorinated Biphenyl (PCB) Waste Operations, Cal. Code Regs., title 22, section 66263.44.

Allows a governmental agency or public utility to transport its own PCB waste to a central collection facility using a shipping paper instead of a hazardous waste manifest. Handling and storage time for the waste shall meet the provisions of Cal. Code Regs., title 22, section 66263.18, and must then be manifested to an authorized facility.
